	and hear their recommendations.
	- Given Ainsley Carry's position as VP Students, the Task Force also asked
	questions and provided feedback on the matter of transphobic speakers.
	Ainsley Carry shared the updated process that UBC now uses to assess
	external speakers, which more explicitly considers the impacts in terms of
	human rights.
	- Information and recommendations discussed during this conversation will
	be integrated in more detail into the Task Force's final recommendations.
